Beginning Piano

Students **MUST** have a working instrument to practice on at home. The instrument can be an acoustic piano (best), a digital piano (excellent), or a portable keyboard (cheapest solution and will get you through the course, although not a “serious” instrument to learn on). Piano and music stores will sell or rent only digital pianos or acoustic pianos. You cannot buy or rent portable keyboards from music stores.

Students will be given a set of books to purchase. I will hand them out at the first or second class. These books will total about \$10-\$15.

Optional items:

- metronome - helps improve rhythm and timing
- fun music - browse through the music store for music that you’d like to play. Look for music marked “5-finger” music for the simplest arrangements.
