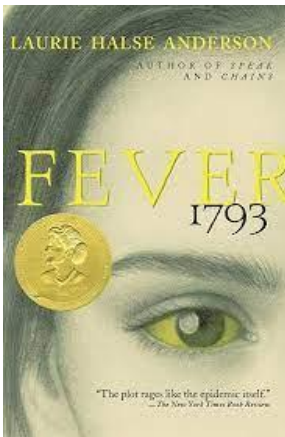


Summer Reading
